EXAM DESCRIPTION

Dear Candidate,

Exam in English for foreign candidates wishing to study at Academy of Social Sciences consists of two parts: a written test and a spoken test. The expected language level of the candidates is B2

Admissions Office will send the candidates the joining instructions specifying the date, time and the password to access the tests.

The written test is administered via Moodle platform.

The speaking test will be administered online, too, via MS Teams.

Information concerning the written test:

You will sit a written examination in English as a Foreign Language.

It lasts 35 minutes.

There are three exam tasks: grammar multiple choice test, vocabulary multiple choice test and a cloze test where you write one word in each blank space.

Each correct answer will give you one point. The whole test is worth 30 points. The passing score is 60% or 18 points.

Information concerning the spoken test:

You will have a 10 to 12-minute interview conducted by two examiners. You will be given a question to answer which will be followed by a short discussion with the examiners.

Please have your passport ready to prove your identity.

The hours of the oral exam will be set individually, about which the candidates will be notified the day before.
